MINUTES: Motion made/accepted to approve September minutes as submitted.

REPORTS (Executive Board): All officer's reports reviewed.

Chair (Ro M):Report reviewed. Still reaching out out to IR's to try to increase GPI participation. Working on Bylaws to ensure compliance with WSO guidelines..

Ex-Officio (Kristi K): Report reviewed. Mentor program to support new IR's will need guidance to continue as Kristi leaves the Ex-Officio role..

Treasurer (Dee C.) - Financials Reviewed. Budget will be adjusted for 2025 because the Park my phone change will save us about \$684 in the next year. Ro added that we will take another look at our WSO contributions schedule after the website updates are completed.

Secretary (Sheree C): Report Reviewed.

Webmaster (Jessica): report reviewed. Jessica will be updating the website in stages. There is nothing up to see as of yet, but Jessica shared some of her work in progress with the group.
